1. By way of present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 & 4 to conduct a fair and proper investigation by recording statements of petitioners.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representation dated 20.11.2023 (Annexure P-1) moved at the instance of petitioners by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

3. Prayer seems to be justified.

4. Upon advance notice, Mr. Shubham Kaushik, AAG, Punjab appears on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

5. In view of the aforesaid, but without going into the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 & 4 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, Punjab & Incharge, Economic Offences Wing, Amritsar to look into the representation dated 20.11.2023 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 08 (eight) weeks’ from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
