1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking directions to respondent No. 2 to decide application dated 08.07.2023 (Annexure P-36) seeking NOC in terms of Rule 144 of Petroleum Rules, 2002.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited (in short “HPCL”) has issued Letter of Intent in favour of petitioner for setting-up of retail outlet. The HPCL has filed an application under Rule 144 of Petroleum Rules seeking NOC. The application was filed on 08.07.2023, however, till date District Magistrate has not decided the said application.
