1. By way of present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., a prayer has been made for issuance of direction to official respondents to take necessary action against accused persons for committing forgery with the petitioner.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the official respondents to decide the representation dated 30.05.2022 (Annexure P-5) moved at the instance of petitioner by passing a speaking order expeditiously.
3. Prayer seems to be justified.
4. Upon advance notice, Mr. Krishan K. Chahal, Addl. A.G., Haryana appears on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6 and raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.
5. In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going

into the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Palwal, District Palwal to look into the representation dated 30.05.2022 (Annexure P-5) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 08 (eight) weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
