The attention has been drawn of this Court to para 4 of the said

affidavit, which reads as under:-

“That it needs to be emphasized here that the above noted CWP No.258/2020 Ram Kumar Bhayan and ors v. State of Haryana and others was filed in first week of January-2020 praying for reimbursement of their pending medical bills which could not be released for want of necessary approval from Registrar Cooperative Society, Haryana and immediately on receipt of approval from the Registrar as is evident from the order dated 09.10.2020 passed by this Hon'ble Court, payments 09.10.2020 were of all released medical to bills petitioners pending as in terms on of approval granted by the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana. The writ petition has become infructuous but is being kept pending by the petitioners on one pretext or the other for reasons best known to them.”

A perusal of the aforesaid reproduced paragraph establish that payments of all medical bills pending as on 09.10.2020 have been released to the petitioners as approved by the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana and, therefore the deponent has prayed for disposal of the writ petition, as having become infructuous.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In the light of above, petition stands disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
