Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2, 3 and 4 for conducting the demarcation of the land of petitioner in presence of representative of respondent No.4 in a time bound manner. Further prayer has been made directing respondent No.2 to take appropriate action against respondent No.5-Tehsildar, Mohali for falling to conduct the demarcation of the petitioner's land, the request of which is pending since 07.09.2021. Further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.5 to conduct demarcation in accordance with law and as per the provisions of Section 101 of Land Revenue Act, 1887.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioners have filed the petition for demarcation of his land and the officials also came present at the place. He submits that the report was submitted on 21.09.2022 wherein it was specifically observed that demarcation could not be carried out because of the absence of the concerned revenue staff of the PUDA. He further submits that the petitioners are approaching the respondents-authorities time and again

with the request to the revenue officials of PUDA to be present but in vain and hence, the demarcation as prayed by the petitioners is not carried out till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Heard. After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file fresh petition for carrying out demarcation before respondent No.5-Tehsildar, SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab within a week from today. If any such petition is filed, respondent No.5 would carry out necessary demarcation as prayed for within four weeks thereafter. It is further directed that the concerned revenue officials of the PUDA would also be associated at the time of demarcation of the land. This order be conveyed to the PUDA Authorities.
