The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 48 dated 11.05.2017, registered under Sections 307 (deleted later on as has been submitted by learned counsel for the parties), 364, 382, 342, 323, 506, 148, 149 of IPC and 66E/67 of I.T. Act at Police Station Hathur, District Ludhiana (P-1) on the basis of compromise (P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 21.12.2018 and 11.02.2019, report dated 23.12.2022 has been received from Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Jagraon, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.
