This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to get an inquiry conducted from some independent agency regarding embezzlement, misuse of panchayat funds and irregularities in disbursing the old age pension committed by respondent No.4 and other committee members.

On 17.03.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-
