In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that he is entitled for extension of service on the post of Peon on which post he is working through the outsourcing policy part-II.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's salary starting from the year 2018 has not been paid, hence, respondents are liable to be directed to grant the petitioner the arrears of salary from February, 2018 onward, especially when the petitioner is working on the post in question.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 12.08.2023 (Annexure P-17) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in

case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 12.08.2023 (Annexure P-17) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of six weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to him within a further period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
