The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to direct the respondents to produce the alleged detainee namely Davinder Kumar, who had been illegally detained by the police officers.

Pursuant to the notice, Ms. Vasundhara Dalal Anand, Additional P.P., U.T., Chandigarh has appeared on behalf of U.T., Chandigarh.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Insp. Ashok Kumar, P.S. Crime Branch, Chandigarh submits that the alleged detainee namely Davinder Kumar was arrested by the U.T. Police in case FIR No.444 dated 02.12.2023, P.S. Sector-36, Chandigarh and vide the order dated 10.12.2023, the Duty Magistrate has sent the alleged detainee namely Davinder Kumar on police remand for six days. She further submits that alleged detainee namely Davinder Kumar has been arrested by the U.T., Police after following the due process of law.

In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the present petition is accordingly disposed of.
