The present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, praying for punishing the respondent for willfully disobeying order dated 09.02.2023 (Annexure P-2), passed by this Court in CWP 2668-2023.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amit Aggarwal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and submits that the order qua which the contempt is alleged has since been complied with and the respondent department has granted IIIrd ACP to the petitioner as JBT with effect from 01.09.2019 after completion of 24 years of regular satisfactory services.

Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, then he would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
