Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner, who is working as Senior Medical Officer, Incharge Radiology Department, Civil Hospital, Bhiwani, has not been paid the salary starting from June, 2023 and the petitioner has also not been released the LTC/HTC for the block year 2020-2023. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a delay in processing the case of the petitioner for the grant of benefit under the Assured Career Progression Scheme. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has not been treated fairly by the respondents during his service career, hence, petitioner has been forced to approach this Court claiming the relief as raised in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 06.11.2023 (Annexure P-8) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 06.11.2023 (Annexure P-8) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of six weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to him within a further period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
