Present writ petition has been filed for directing respondent No.2 to take an appropriate action as provided under Section 51(3) of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 as respondent No.3 has encroached upon the Government land as per report dated 21.10.2022 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted before this Court that for the redressal of grievance of the petitioner, she has already filed her representation dated 27.07.2023 (Annexure P-4) before respondent No.2 but no decision has been taken on the same till date. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Upasna Dhawan, AAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. She, on

instructions from Mr. Vikas, SEPO, Rewari, has submitted that cognizance has already been taken by respondent No.2 on the representation filed by the petitioner and the inquiry has also been marked to the Social Education Panchayat Officer. She submits that the same would be concluded within a period of two weeks and on receiving the report from the SEPO, further action would be taken accordingly.

In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Deputy Commissioner, Rewari to complete the proceedings initiated on receiving the report from the SEPO expeditiously in accordance with law preferably within a period of six weeks thereafter.
