1. This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. read with Section 3 of the Punjab Good Conduct of Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 for issuance of directions to respondent No. 2, i.e. the District Magistrate, Jalandhar, to consider and decide the application of the petitioner for grant of parole for 08 weeks to meet the family members.

[2] Counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer only for issuance of a direction to decide the representation dated 18.07.2023 (Annexure P-1) by the District Magistrate, Jalandhar (respondent No. 2).

[3] Notice of motion.

[4] Having received advance copy of the petition, Mr. Harpreet Singh, Addl. A.G., Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents No. 1 to 3. Keeping in view the innocuous prayer made, this Court is of the opinion that there is no need to seek written response from the respondents.

[5] In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the District Magistrate, Jalandhar (respondent No. 2) to consider

and decide the representation dated 18.07.2023 (Annexure P-1) and if he finds some action in the matter is warranted, then the needful be done in accordance with law, within a period of one month from the date of the receipt of the certified copy of this order.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
