1. This writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 06.10.2022 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.1.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that inadvertently the orders dated 09.02.2015, 19.05.2015 and 20.10.2016 have neither been challenged nor have been placed on record and thus, the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after laying challenge to the said orders and after giving full and better particulars.
3. In view of the above-said statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
4. It is made clear that in case any such petition is filed by the petitioner, all issues including the issue of delay would be considered independently, in accordance with law.
