1. Petitioner (M/s HAK Traders) has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 18.09.2023/06.10.2023 (Annexure P-1), passed by the Presiding Officer, Central Government Industrial Tribunal-I, Chandigarh, whereby the statutory appeal filed by petitioner has been dismissed being barred by limitation.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for petitioner submits that there are some inadvertent mistakes in the instant writ petition, therefore, he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to file fresh one with better particulars on the same cause of action.
