Present writ petition has been filed for directing the official respondents to take appropriate action on the representation of the petitioner dated 27.03.2023 (Annexure P-5). Further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.3 to properly implement the parking norms in the area where the property in question is situated, so that the petitioner may not face any problems being created by the resident of adjoining house who is illegally parking his three cars in the street in front of the house/shop of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted before this Court that for the redressal of grievance of the petitioner, he has already filed his representation dated 27.03.2023 (Annexure P-5) before respondent No.3 but no decision has been taken on the same till date. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the same in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rohit Kaushik, Advocate appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-UT and has stated that representation made by the petitioner would be decided expeditiously.

In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 27.03.2023 (Annexure P-5) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from today.
