1. Prayer in the second petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.344 dated 14.12.2017, under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, registered at Police Station Division No.7, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.
2. A perusal of para 12 of the petition reveals that the first petition was withdrawn vide order dated 03.11.2023 to enable the petitioner to avail his remedy in accordance with law in light of the fact that petitioner was declared a proclaimed person vide order dated 31.08.2022.
3. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition without prejudice to his rights to avail his remedy against the aforesaid order dated 31.08.2022.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
