Prayer in this 2nd petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.0176 dated 28.09.2023 registered under Sections 22, 29, 61 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station Garshankar, District Hoshiarpur.

Earlier petition bearing No.CRM-M-57399-2023 was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 15.11.2023, which is as under :-

“After arguing for some time, statement is made by learned counsel for the petitioner, so as to withdraw this petition with liberty to surrender before the Police Authorities. Learned counsel also seeks liberty that as an when application for regular bail is moved, the same be disposed of expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.”

Learned counsel contends that there is change in circumstances inasmuch as co-accused Sandeep Kaur @ Krishna Rani has been granted the similar benefit.

Having regard the stand taken by the petitioner in the earlier petition whereby he had sought liberty to surrender before the police authorities and the petition was dismissed as withdrawn, after arguing for some time, there is no justification to consider the second petition.

Dismissed.
