The present petition under Section 226 of Constitution of India to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No.9 to 11 regarding which complaints/applications dated 29.11.2023 and 02.12.2023 (Annexure P-13 and Annexure P-15) were given to respondents No. 1 to 3.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner being aggrieved by the act and conduct of respondent No.4 to 11 had moved representations to higher authorities time and again as they were illegally trying to take possession of the property with the help of police but no action has been taken thereon. He submits that feeling apprehension to his life and liberty, the petitioner had preferred representations, latest Annexure P-13 and Annexure P-15 to respondent

No.2 and 3 dated 29.11.2023 and 02.12.2023 respectively, but till date no action thereon has been taken. He submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-13 and Annexure P-15) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. After considering the respective submissions and considering the averments made in the petition, without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is, hereby, disposed of with direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-13 and Annexure P-15) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

6. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.

7. Disposed of.
