Present writ petition has been filed for directing respondent No.2 to de-seal the shop under tenancy of the petitioner as the same has been sealed without any notice/intimation and in complete contravention of principles of natural justice. Further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.2 to decide the representation (Annexure P-4) submitted to the respondents seeking de-sealing of the shop.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted before this Court that shop of the petitioner has been illegally sealed without even serving any prior notice on him. He submits that the petitioner is seriously prejudiced as the only source of her livelihood has been stopped due to the shop having been sealed illegally. He submits that for the redressal of grievance of the petitioner, she has already filed her representation Annexure P-4 before respondent No.2 but no decision has been taken on the same till date. He further submits that the petitioner

will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Phagwara, Punjab to decide the representation of the petitioner Annexure P-4 in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from today.
