RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for non-compliance with the terms and conditions as outlined in the mutually agreed upon settlement and subsequent addendum dated 29.06.2019 as confirmed by the Principal District Judge, Gurugram Family Court, vide order dated 22.10.2019.

Perusal of the file shows that the order qua which the contempt is alleged is of the nature, for determination of contempt for which a lot of disputed questions would be required to be adjudicated upon. However, adjudication of disputed questions of facts would not even be appropriate in the contempt petition. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to make appropriate application for execution of the order passed by the trial Court or to make any other prayer or to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
