Petitioner was convicted under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act by the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla in complaint case No.NACT/817/2019 titled as “M/s Nivdeep Tyres Vs. Karamjit Singh”.

Petitioner challenged conviction by filing appeal. Learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur vide impugned order dated 15.09.2023, though suspended the sentence and admitted the petitioner to bail but asked him to deposit 20% of the total compensation amount within stipulated period.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks extension of time so as to deposit 20% of the total compensation amount as due to some financial constraints in the family, the petitioner could not do so.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to make compliance of the impugned order dated 15.09.2023 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur, on or before 15.01.2024.
