HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)

1. By way of present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to take appropriate legal action on the representation/complaint dated 30.11.2023 (Annexure P-3) moved at the instance of petitioner for protection of his life and liberty.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the respondent No.1 and 2 to decide the representation/complaint dated 30.11.2023 (Annexure P-3) moved at the instance of petitioner by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

3. Prayer seems to be justified.

4. Upon advance notice, Mr. Krishan K. Chahal, Addl. A.G., Haryana

appears on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

5. In view of the aforesaid, but without going into the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, Haryana to look into the representation dated 30.11.2023 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 08 (eight) weeks’ from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
