1. This is a second petition filed under Section 482 read with Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner for a period of 15 days on the ground that his real brother had died on 07.12.2023 in case bearing FIR No.216, dated 01.09.2022, under Sections 302, 120-B, 109, 201 IPC and Section 25(1B)(a) of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Gurugram.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the customary ceremonies of his brother is to be held on 17.12.2023 at his native village. He further submitted that earlier the petitioner had filed a petition for grant of interim regular bail and this Court on 09.11.2023 had granted the interim regular bail to the petitioner to meet his brother, who has now died, on three dates, but under the strict security arrangement subject to payment of expenses for the aforesaid by the petitioner or his relatives in advance, but the same benefit was not availed by the petitioner.

3. On the other hand, Mr. Vishal Kashyap, learned DAG, Haryana has stated that he has sought instructions in the present case and stated that the petitioner is a hardcore criminal and is involved in as many as five more cases and two cases are under Section 302 IPC. He further submitted that he has also sought instructions to state that there is a strong apprehension that in case the petitioner is released on interim bail then he may abscond or flee from justice or may repeat the offence.

4. After hearing the learned counsels for the parties, this Court does not find any ground to grant interim bail to the petitioner. Consequently, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
