The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the official respondents to look into the matter and take strict legal action against the private respondents/accused in pursuance of a case bearing FIR No.0045 dated 07.06.2023 under Sections 323/324/506/427/34 of IPC (Annexure P-1) and FIR No.0101 dated 28.11.2023 (Annexure P-2) under Sections 452/323/506/427/148/149 of IPC registered at Police Station Ladhuwal, District Ludhiana and further protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as well as their family members at the hands of private respondents.

Brief facts of the case are that on 23.05.2023 at about 07:00 A.M. without any reason, the private respondents gave beatings and attributed injuries with the sharp edged weapons to the petitioners and when the petitioners approached the local police authorities, they kept dilly-dallying the matter on one pretext or the other and in the name of inquiry, called the petitioners and their family members number of times at the police station and

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pressurized them to settle the matter and eventually, the petitioners filed detailed representation dated 01.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) to the various authorities along with respondent No.2 but till today no action has been taken and thus, the petitioners have approached this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that the petitioners would be satisfied in case, a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 01.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. I.P.S.Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State and copy of the petition has been supplied in the Court.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioners and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 01.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioners within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
