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MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J.(ORAL)

By filing this petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner-wife has sought the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of the direction to learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Panipat (for short 'the Family Court') to decide the Divorce Petition bearing ***DMC No.342 of 2020*** titled as "***Tarun Jethi vs. Sonia Jethi and others***" filed by respondent No.1-husband under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act of 1955') within the period of six months, while averring that the afore-said Petition had been filed in August, 2020 and the same has not yet been decided.

3. Keeping in view the fact that the above-mentioned Divorce Petition is pending adjudication for the last more than three years as well as the provisions contained in Section 21-B of the Act of 1955 and without
