1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue directions to respondents No. 4 and 5 not to harass the petitioner by calling on the police station again and again.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is having a civil dispute with Harcharan Singh, respondent No. 6. Even, a civil litigation is pending between both the parties. Learned counsel further contends that the respondent No. 6, who is a NRI has moved the complaints to the police station only with a view to harass and humiliate the petitioner and his father. He further contends that whenever a complaint is made falsely by respondent No. 6, an inquiry is initiated by the police without any lawful

justification. In this manner, the petitioner is being harassed by respondents No. 4 and 5 by calling in the police station again and again without following the due process of the law.

3. On advance notice, Mr. M.S. Bajwa, DAG, Punjab, has appeared on behalf of the official respondents. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh submits that the FIR No. 69 dated 27.04.2023 under Section 379 and 420 at Police Station Phillaur has been registered against the present petitioner and his father on the basis of complaint moved by the respondent No. 6. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has been summoned by the police in connection with the investigation of the said case. Even, the petitioner has also filed a representation to the higher police officer for fair investigation and the petitioner was also called in connection with the inquiry of the said representation. He submits that the investigation of the said representation submitted by the present petitioner has been marked to DSP Phillaur. Learned counsel has further assured the Court that the investigation in the said case shall be conducted fairly and impartially. Learned counsel further assured the Court that the petitioner shall not be harassed by the police, in connection with the various complaints filed by respondent No. 6. He further assured the Court that the petitioner is required in any complaint, which has been/may be submitted by respondent No. 6, due procedure as established by law shall be followed.

4. In view of above, no further directions are required and the petition is, accordingly, disposed off.
