1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that the recommendation of the Pharmacy Council of India to the 5th Central Pay Commission be implemented in its letter and spirit so that the Department could work in a smooth manner as recommended by the Pharmacy Council of India.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though a sufficient period has already expired but no action is being taken by the respondents, which is causing prejudice to the petitioners.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the grievance which has been raised in the present writ petition, has already been raised by the petitioners in the representation dated 17.10.2022, a copy of which has been appended with this petition as Annexure P-10 and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an

appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case representation dated 17.10.2022 (Annexure P-10) is received from the petitioners and is pending consideration with the authorities concerned, appropriate order on the same will be passed by the respondents within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and in case after passing of the speaking order, any action needs to be taken, the same will be taken as expeditiously as possible.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
