1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 06.04.2022 (Annexure P-5).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that inadvertently, Notification dated 01.11.2021 has not been challenged in the present writ petition and thus, he seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition after laying challenge to the Notification dated 01.11.2021 and after giving full and better particulars.
3. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
4. It is made clear that in case any such fresh petition is filed then the same would be considered independently, in accordance with law.
