Respondents No.5 to 7 cannot take possession of the vehicle of the petitioner forcibly except in accordance with the procedure established by law. It is also contended that the guidelines on Fair Practices Code of the respondent-Bank (Annexure P-3) specifically stipulate that in the matter of recovery of loans, the bank would not resort to undue harassment or use of force for recovery.

Notice of motion to official respondents only.

Mr. I.P.S. Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper book. With the consent of parties, the case is taken up for final disposal.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner undertakes that he will continue to pay the remaining installments, the official respondents are directed to restore the possession of the vehicle in question to the petitioner within a week and the petitioner is directed to continue to pay the remaining installments from time to time without any default. As per the undertaking given by the petitioner, he shall pay the balance amount as per the directions given by this Court, failing which, he will surrender the vehicle to private respondents.

The instant petition stands disposed of in above terms.
