1. The petitioner who is an employee of the Primo Chemical Ltd. has preferred this writ petition.
2. Admittedly, the State Government has no share with the Primo Chemicals Limited nor has it any control over the same.
3. In view of the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Pradeep Kumar Biswas vs. Indian Institute of Chemical Biology and others (2002) 5 SCC 111**, the present writ petition is not maintainable.
4. In view of the above, the writ petition is dismissed as not maintainable. However, the petitioner would be free to take remedy as available under the law for claiming dues as against the concerned company.
