This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 23.11.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-26412-2023.

Mr. Saurav Verma, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and Mr. Vikas Singh, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2. Learned counsel for respondent No.1 has pointed out that in the first instance, the paddy was allotted to the petitioner as per the entitlement. Even from the subsequent purchase, the paddy was allotted and given to the petitioner-mill, however, the said lot was rejected by the petitioner himself.

Since, the disputed questions of facts are involved, therefore, this Court does find it appropriate to interfere in the matter.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to raise its appropriate claim before the appropriate Court, but in accordance with law.
