1. On the oral request of the learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent No. 2- Deputy Commissioner, Ambala is substituted with Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Kurukshetra in the array of respondents in the memo of parties relating to the instant writ petition.
2. Registry is directed to carry out necessary corrections in the memo of parties.
3. The learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him by the officer concerned, submits that the verdict of eviction, as carried in Annexure P-3, has acquired finality and conclusivity.
4. Annexure P-3 became rendered on 25.03.2022.
5. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that till now no efficacious steps have been taken either at the instance of the learned Executing Court concerned, or by the Executing Officer concerned, nor by the decree holders concerned, to ensure that the said binding and conclusive decree of eviction becomes successfully executed upon the

6. The learned State Counsel states that as a matter of fact there is gross slothfulness on the part of all concerned, to ensure the successful execution of the warrants of possession, upon, the judgment debtors concerned.
7. Therefore, this Court is constrained to make direction(s) upon the Collector of the Revenue District concerned, to ensure that a notice be issued upon the derelicting officers concerned, thus seeking an explanation from them vis-a-vis the reasons prevailing upon them to not till now ensure the completest and successful execution of Annexure P-3.
8. Be that as it may, both the learned Executing Court concerned, and, the Executing Officer concerned, are directed to ensure that within a month from today, completest and successful satisfaction is made on the warrants of possession.
