The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred by the petitioner seeking directions to the official respondents No.2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their families by taking appropriate actions/ measures against the private respondents No.6 to 12.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioners, being aggrieved by the acts and conducts of private respondents No.6 to 12, had filed various representations to the police authorities seeking protection of their life and liberty, but no action thereon has been taken. He submits that even the representation dated 25.08.2023 (Annexure P-9) was moved to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar, but till date no action thereon has been taken. He further submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent

of Police, Amritsar, to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-9) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner by giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner as well.

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Anmol Singh Sandhu, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.
- 5. Heard.
- 6. After considering the respective submissions and considering the averments made in the petition, without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is, hereby, disposed of with direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar, to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-9) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner after giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner as well.
- 7. The final outcome of the representation be also intimated to the petitioner.
- 8. Disposed of.
