1. By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioners are seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Gaurav Bansal, DAG, Haryana, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.
4. As per petitioners, they have married on 15.12.2023 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6, who happen to be the relatives of petitioner No.2 i.e. Sabnam.
5. Both the petitioners claim themselves to be major stating that petitioner No.1-Ajhruddin is 05.06.1996 born and petitioner No.2-Sabnam is 01.01.1992 born as per their Aadhar Cards.
6. Without commenting on the legality and validity of the marriage, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to consider the

representation dated 18.12.2023 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioners.

7. Keeping in view the fact that both the petitioners claim to have married, I think that if possible, respondent No.2 may call a meeting of the petitioners as well as respondents No.4 to 6 in his presence, so that the parties get rid off their ill feelings and live amicably.
8. The petition stands disposed off.
9. Since the main case has been decided, pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed off.
