1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition, seeking issuance of appropriate directions to the respondents No. 2 and 3 to decide the representation dated 06.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner before the Director General of Police, Punjab Police Head Quarters, Sector 9 and the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been running from pillar to post but her grievance was not being redressed by the respondent authorities. Having been left with no other option, petitioner has approached the Director General of Police, Punjab Police Head Quarters, Sector 9 and the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, respondent No.2 by way of

representation dated 06.12.2023 (Annexure P-2), but the same is also pending decision. He also submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 06.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two months from today.
