1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of appropriate directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 for taking appropriate action against an unknown person in an incident of firing and injuring the petitioner with bullet shot.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representation dated 03.05.2023 (Annexure P-2) moved at the instance of petitioner by passing a speaking order expeditiously.
3. Prayer seems to be justified.
4. Upon advance notice, Mr. Sandeep Yadav, D.A.G., Punjab appears on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

5. In view of the aforesaid, but without going into the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar to look into the representation dated 03.05.2023 (Annexure P-2) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 08 (eight) weeks' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
