By way of present writ petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, prayer has been made for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of the private respondents and further prayer is made for directing respondent No.2 to decide the representation (Annexure P-1).
