The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to conduct the fair investigation by some higher officials in representation dated 03.10.2023 (Annexure P-7) as the private respondents committed cheating and fraud with the petitioner.

Brief facts of the case are that petitioner was willing to go to Canada and therefore, he visited the office of respondent No.4 where other private respondents met with the petitioner and allured him that there is 100% guarantee of VISA and if visa has been rejected for any reason, the amount paid by the petitioner will be refunded. On this pretext, the private respondents took the passport and other relevant documents from the petitioner followed by demand of Rs.30,000/- which was paid by the petitioner by way of online transaction. The private respondents further took an amount of Rs.14,75,000/- from the petitioner for the whole process and passed one year in the visa

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process on one pretext or the other. Aggrieved by this, the petitioner moved representation dated 03.10.2023 (Annexure P-7) to respondents No.2 & 3 but no action has been taken so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that he would be satisfied in case, a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 03.10.2023 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 03.10.2023 (Annexure P-7) submitted by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
