The instant writ petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to consider the case of the present petitioner as per rules and to decide the legal notice dated 15.04.2023 (Annexure P-8) served by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

The facts as averred in the present writ petition are that the petitioner applied for the post of Science Teacher (TGT) and appeared in the written test held by the Haryana State Selection Commission and was accordingly selected. However, she was not asked for any option regarding choice of Station and was allotted a station which was far away from the

residence of the petitioner. She instead of joining immediately moved a representation to adjust her in any other nearby station. It is averred that thereafter when the list was out, the petitioner on 14.01.2009 rushed to the office of respondent No.3-District Education Officer (SE), however, she was asked to come in the morning on 15.01.2009 and on the same date respondent No.3 instructed the school to get her joined on 15.01.2009 but the school authorities asked her to come in the morning on 16.01.2009 and accordingly her joining date has been shown as 16.01.2009 instead of 15.01.2009. It is averred that the petitioner moved various representations dated 27.12.2010, 10.05.2017 and 14.07.2022 and also sent reminders but all in vain. It is further averred that due to the discrepancy in the date of joining, the petitioner is suffering a loss of Rs.1,400/- per month. It is further averred that the petitioner served a legal notice dated 15.04.2023 (Annexure P-8), however, since no decision on the same has been taken, the present writ petition has been filed.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vivek Saini, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He submit that the primary prayer made by the petitioner in the present writ petition is to decide the legal notice dated 15.04.2023 (Annexure P-8) and therefore, the present writ petition can be disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Commissioner-cum-Director General, School Education, Haryana, to decide the same in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-the Commissioner-cum-Director General, School Education, Haryana,

to decide the legal notice dated 15.04.2023 (Annexure P-8) sent by the petitioner and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
