1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition, seeking issuance of appropriate directions to the respondents-authorities to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No. 301 dated 26.08.2023 under Sections 302, 323, 148, 149 and 506 of IPC and under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Ferozepur Jhirka, District Nuh (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been running from pillar to post but his grievance was not being redressed by the respondent authorities. Having been left with no other option, petitioner has approached the Superintendent of Police, District Nuh-respondent No.2 by way of representation dated

16.11.2023 (Annexure P-4), but the same is also pending decision. He also submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, District Nuh, respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 16.11.2023 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two months from today.
