1. By way of present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for issuance of direction to the official respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners from the private respondents.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representation dated 18.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) moved at the instance of petitioners by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

3. Prayer seems to be justified.

4. Upon advance notice, Mr. Krishan K. Chahal, Addl. A.G., Haryana appears on behalf of respondents Nos.1 to 3 and raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

5. In view of the aforesaid, but without going into the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Sirsa to look into the representation dated 18.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 08 (eight) weeks' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
