In the present petition, the grievance of the present petitioner is that the mother of the petitioner who was working as Multi Purpose Health Worker (Female) with the respondent, unfortunately died on 02.12.2008, but the petitioner and his brother who were minor at that stage, petitioner has now raised the claim for the grant of compassionate appointment, which is not being granted to him.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the instructions issued by the Government of Haryana even as of now, the petitioner is eligible for the grant of compassionate appointment.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 30.05.2022 copy of which has been appended as (Annexure P-9) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation 30.05.2022 (Annexure P-9) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to him within a further period of four weeks.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
