I.A. 22147/2023 (u/S 151 of CPC, 1908)

1. The present Application under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 has been jointly filed on behalf of the parties seeking to take on record the MoU dated 27.09.2023 and grant permission to withdraw the present petition in terms of the said MoU.
2. It is submitted that the matter parties have arrived at a settlement *vide* MoU dated 27.09.2023. Therefore, a request is made that the present petition may be disposed of in terms of the MoU dated 27.09.2023.
