2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that Statutory Appeal of the petitioner is pending consideration and shall be disposed of in accordance with law.



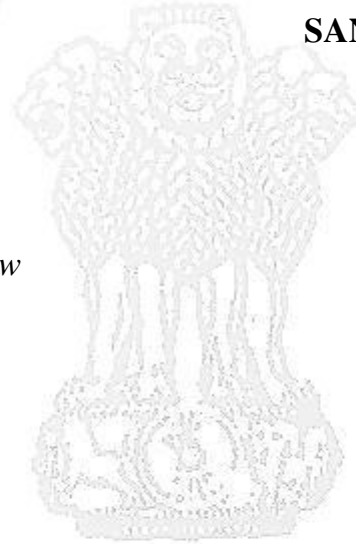
3. The petition is accordingly disposed of directing the respondents to dispose of the Statutory Appeal of the petitioner as expeditiously as possible in accordance with law.
