The instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner, **Ravi Shankar Singh**, seeking following reliefs:-

"I. To issue a writ of certiorari to quash the order of CAT Lucknow dated 28.11.2022, annexed as Annexure No.1.

II. To issue a writ of certiorari to quash the order dated 16.05.2018 & dated 25.02.2014 denying re-fixation of salary, annexed as Annexure 5 at page No.55 and 56.

III. To issue a writ of mandamus directing, to the opposite parties to notionally re-fix applicant salary at par with his juniors from 22.05.1989 & fix actually when he joined service with consequential benefits in both ASM as well as Control cadre & to pay arrears of salary with interest after re-fixation at par with his juniors.

IV. To allow the cost of application in favour of applicant.

V. To issue any other direction or order in favour of applicant which this Hon'ble Tribunal deems fit, proper & necessary under circumstances of the case."

Shri Ravi Shankar Singh, petitioner-in-person, submits that as his grievances made in the instant writ petition have been addressed by the authority concerned, therefore, he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition and the writ petition be dismissed as withdrawn.

In view of the above, the instant writ petition is **dismissed as withdrawn without any further liberty.**
