Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Bhagwanpur P.S. Case No. 233 of 2023, lodged on 04.10.2023,
under Sections 147,148,149,120B of the Indian Penal Code and
under Sections 25(1-b)A/26/35 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution, FIR has been lodged against
eight named accused persons including the petitioner. The
recovery of one country-made pistol and four live cartridges has
been made from the conscious possession of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He submits
that antecedent of the petitioner is clean and he is in custody
since 05.10.2023.



5. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that recovery of arms and ammunition has been made from the conscious possession of the petitioner and only four months have crossed.

6. On specific query whether charges have been framed or not. Counsel for the petitioner submits that he is completely unaware about this fact that charges have been framed or not.

7. In this background, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is rejected. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner that he may renew his prayer for bail after nine months.
