8 16-07-2024 After some argument, learned counsel for the
petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition.

2. Permission is accorded.

3. Accordingly, the instant petition is dismissed as
withdrawn.

4. However, learned appellate court is reminded that
when a Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated
05.09.2022 passed in Civil Misc. No.44 of 2020 requested it to
dispose of the appeal on its merit as early as possible preferably
within three months, it was expected that appeal would be
disposed of within stipulated period. But, as has been submitted
by the parties, the appeal is pending even after much time has
elapsed since the date of passing of the aforesaid order of the
Coordinate Bench.



5. Under the circumstances, the learned appellate court is directed to dispose of the appeal on its merit within three months and it is made clear that non-compliance would be viewed seriously entailing severe consequences.
