A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for the informant.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 304(B) / 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. It is a case of 'Dowry Death'.

4. Petitioner is father-in-law of the deceased and has been roped in this case with general and omnibus allegation. Informant is not eye-witness to the occurrence. Thrust of the accusation is against husband of the deceased. Petitioner is in custody since 19.03.2023. Chargesheet has been submitted.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for the informant vehemently opposes the prayer for bail.

6. However, considering the aforesaid facts and



circumstances as well as period of custody, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.D.J. - XIV, Patna / concerned court in connection with Sessions Trial No. 788 of 2023, arising out of Krishna Nagar P.S. Case No. 177 of 2023.
