2 02-05-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

"1. (i) For issuance of an appropriate writ/ order or direction to remove the encroachment from Mazua-Andhrathari, Khata No. 2833 (New), Kheshra No. 631, 638, 642, (Old) 517, 516, 1645, 1649 (New) 1454 and 1455 (New), old Kheshra No. 966 and Kheshra No. 1141 1145 and 1138 968, 965 Sarkari Nala Kheshra No. ? (Road) under Sections 2 (3), 3, 6 (b) and 8 of the Bihar Public Road Encroachment Act, 1956.

(ii) For issuance of an appropriate



writ/order or direction to first measurement of the said above plots including Kheshra No. 967 (Ne) and 1211 old (Talab Private of this petitioner) and remove the encroachment from the encroachers who have encroached their road as well as some parts of Talab Jointly."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent no. 4 i.e. the Circle Officer, Andharathari, District-Madhubani, for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off.
